<u>Kinreve trial</u> <u>Standard Class</u> Sunday 27th April

It was a misty start to the day for the Kinreve Trial, it's not everyone's favourite site due to the type of terrain. If the site is wet you get bottomless peat bog and spend all day doing recoveries but if it's dry the ground is hard and it is difficult to find challenges for the drivers. This year we decided to use some areas in Kinreve that haven't been used before, to try to freshen things up and change peoples view of the site. The turn out was quite poor in the standard class with only five starting including two first timers.

For the first sections we headed to the top of the hill to an area of disused peat banks and small mounds. It was here that I learned a vital lesson about setting up sections; don't make them too long because after following 5 Land Rovers round the hill, twice, I was bloody knackered!! Apart from my exhaustion, the first section went without incident. New member Rob Hellet managed to get a clean run round this section in his immaculate, standard Discovery 2. It's a long time since we have had such a standard vehicle taking part with only All Terrain tyres but Rob did remarkably well despite this.

The next sections took us back down the hill slightly. It consisted of sharp climb up a peat bank followed by a gentle run along a grassy slope. First Timer Angus, also in a Discovery 2, cleaned this section with ease. We reversed this section for number 4.

After lunch we moved back to the more familiar areas of the site to tackle some of the short, steep mounds and peat bogs that Kinreve is famous for. Unfortunately at this point we had a couple of retirements; the clutch slave cylinder decided that enough was enough in Ryan MacLenan's bobtailed Range Rover and no matter how much they bled the system the system they couldn't get enough 'pedal' back to continue competing. He did manage however to drive home under his own steam. The second retirement was Rob Hellet in his Discovery who decided to pull out to save the risk of damaging his vehicle, after all, he needs it to get to work and tow the family caravan.

Sections five and six passed by quickly with only Rod Cook needing his 90 recovered after shunting back a little too far into a bog...

The last section of the day was centred round the famous Kinreve mud run. The first set of canes at the beginning, the second set 50m later and the further six sets set out over a few big mounds. Two of the three remaining vehicles had to be recovered from the bog here, that was everyone except James Fraser, does James *ever* get stuck?!?

Thanks to Angus for taking some photos on the day, as I left my camera on the kitchen table. Thanks also to Iain Bannerman for the use of the land at Kinreve, we will be back next year, hopefully with a bigger turn out!

- 1. The H4WDC will promote a cross country Vehicle Trial on Sunday 25th May 2014. The event will be held entirely on private land at Nuide.
- **2.** The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the **RACMSA LTD** (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Codes of the **FISA**), these regulations and any written instructions the Club may issue for the event.
- 3. MSA permit has been applied for. PERMIT No: TBC.
- **4.** The event is open to all fully paid up members of the H4WDC.
- **5.** Competitors must produce a valid club membership card and sign on. Club membership number must be displayed on participating vehicles.
- **6.** The program of the meeting will be as follows:
- (a) Scrutineering starts at **09:15** hrs
- (b) Competitors not signed on by **09:45** hrs may be excluded from this event.
- (c) First vehicle starts at 10:00 hrs
- **7.** Vehicles will fall into classes as per club rules i.e. 80", 86", 90" and LWB. Vehicles may enter into one class only. The starting order on sections will be as per Club Rules. Competitors on the day of competition may be split up into 2 groups.
- **8.** All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations. Passengers may only be carried in accordance with **Rule H. 11.3.2.**
- **9.** The entry fee is **£15** per competitor. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. All officials must also sign-on on the official signing on sheet.
- 10. The secretary for this meeting is:TBA.
- **11.** The maximum entry for this meeting, inc reserves is 40 and the minimum is 10. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting.
