NUIDE TRIAL REPORT – MAY 2019

Set up the sections on the Saturday morning and drove most of them with my disco. Three sections were set up using the loch, but heavy over-night rain swelled the loch by about a foot. 14 drivers turned up on the day including 2 from the Buchan offroad club (Les and Ewan).

1st section was a couple of climbs with a mud hole at the bottom. The rain made this a bit tricky with a lot of the drivers getting stuck in the mud with a lot of winch recoveries.



On to sections 2, 3 and 4 which included a lot of water (I like water). A few thought the water was too deep, but Les from the Buchan club volunteered to go first to try it out. NO PROBLEM. Frank Spencer wasn't happy as his Suzuki didn't have a gaiter around the gearstick and every time in the water a fountain came through the hole and soaked him - was up to the seats at one point.

After the bath the next section, 5, was along a ditch then up a hill which was tricky in the wet. Section 6 had to be altered as the final climb in the wet was a bit too steep and slippy and could have got dangerous. The resulting alterations made it easy.

Section 7 was a different matter, down a hill and 3 crossings of a burn which was swollen with rain water caught a good few out and failed the section and had to be winched out.

Section 8 was back to the ditch and a little bit of water to finish off. Hope everyone enjoyed the sections and the day despite the on-off rain all day **Neil (who also took the photos on this page)**

4X4 TRIAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The H4WDC will promote a cross country Vehicle Trial on

SATURDAY 6th July.

The event will be held entirely on private land at GAIRLOCH.

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the RACMSA LTD (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Codes of the FISA), these regulations and any written instructions the Club may issue for the event.

3. MSA permit has been granted. PERMIT No: 113727.

4. The event is open to all fully paid up members of the H4WDC and BORDC.

5. Competitors must produce a valid club membership card and sign on. Club membership number must be displayed on participating vehicles.

6. The program of the meeting will be as follows:

(a) Scrutineering starts at 09:15 hrs

(b) Competitors not signed on by 09:45 hrs may be excluded from the event.

(c) First vehicle starts at 10:00 hrs

7. Vehicles will fall into classes as per club rules i.e. SWB and LWB. Vehicles may enter into one class only. The starting order on sections will be as per Club Rules. Competitors on the day of competition may be split up into 2 groups.

8. All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations.

Passengers may only be carried in accordance with Rule H. 11.3.2.

9. The entry fee is £15 per competitor. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. All officials must also sign-on on the official signing on sheet.

10. The secretary for this meeting is: **Elaine Smith**.

11. The maximum entry for this meeting, incl reserves is 40 and the minimum is ten. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting.

Scrutineers and Club Marshals: Non-competing / attending Committee Members

13. Results will be available after the competitor completes each section by simply asking the scoring marshal. Results of the event will be published in our monthly newsletter.

14. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with 0.5.1.

You can expect to get more off road driving than at a trial, over an extensive area.

Due to the popularity of this event, it will only be open to **members of the Highland 4 Wheel Drive clu**b and <u>*not*</u> other Motorsport UK affiliated clubs as has been happening with the trials so far this year.

A list of entrants will be published on the club's Facebook page and website at least a week before the event.

Camping is available at Sands camp site – most club members plan to arrive Friday night. On booking, advise them that you are with H4WDC. Everyone entering the camp site MUST report to reception. You will be shown our site.

Please be especially considerate of other camp site users.

All trailers must be parked on the off road site and <u>must not be taken into the camp site.</u> There is a trailer parking area just past the camp site on the right. Go through the gates and up the track. There is an area there.

The event coincides with the Gairloch Gathering. Expect Saturday night to be quite a "social" affair. Don't expect many of your club mates to be getting up early on Sunday...


